I recently attended the State Conventions of both the Marine Corps League and the American Legion held at the Holiday Inn in Kalamazoo and the Hyatt Regency Hotel in Dearborn.

While in Dearborn the new American Legion State Commander Mr. Mike Williams who has been a legionnaire for many years and has held many positions within the Post, District, and State asked me to accept the position of Legislative Affairs Chairman for the Department of Michigan American Legion and I accepted his offer. I look forward to the responsibilities connected to the job and with his and your guidance I know we can and will be successful.

I will be posting a review of all the legislation that has been submitted this year concerning veteran's issues and it will advise you what the legislation is and where it is in the legislative process at this time.

I want all of you to keep in mind the need to stay in contact with those in the halls of government and be sure you express your feelings on those issues affecting our veterans and service members. There are some major concerns with regard to our Veterans Administration and the care and treatment of our wounded and we can not let them be forgotten.

We must remain vigilant and inform those who control the purse strings that they, are going to have to increase the Veterans Administrations budget to fund those rehabilitation programs that will be needed.
